THE FELLOWS EXPERIENCE

Fellows are at the forefront of our mission. Our teams work to cultivate postsecondary-going culture within our schools, collaborate with students and staff to respond to challenges and opportunities, and encourage community support of dreaming big. Stationed full-time in school-based PLUS Centers, our Fellows aim to build transformative relationships with students and empower them to succeed in education and careers beyond the 12th grade.

THE IMPACT

In one year, you will see freshmen and sophomores develop a vision for postsecondary education, juniors rise up to become leaders, and seniors graduate and go on to change the world. Through education, our students will be empowered to break the cycle of poverty in their families and neighborhoods. We have increased college-going rates from 13% to more than 95% at our partner schools over the past ten years. These statistics are more than numbers. They represent our students, the future generation of leaders, with fierce passions, driving motivations, and bright futures.

THE SKILLS

Fellows will learn to be innovative in helping 12+ address one of the most complex problems in our nation: education inequity. Fellows will work as a team to implement school-wide programming through RAISE (freshman transition / high school readiness), Flight (college readiness and access), and PLUS Leaders (student leadership) programs, as well as to plan and execute school-wide events such as College Week and Career Day. Most importantly, Fellows will build relationships with students, learning powerful tools for empowering youth.
